PRE-EVENT SCRUTINY

As per Motorsport Australia's Return to Race COVID-19 Guidelines all Competitors will be required to undertake self scrutiny and complete the **Self Scrutiny Checklist** and **Self Scrutiny Statement of Vehicle Compliance**. Both documents are available from the Official Noticeboard www.targasouthwest.com.au/noticeboard

Please ensure you do a thorough check, not just a 'tick n flick' as Ivan and his team of scrutineers will be doing spot check of various items during the event. If you have any queries or would like to have you vehicle checked anyway please contact us admin@targawest.om.au

RALLYSAFE

All competitors, excluding Targa Tour, **MUST** have a Rallysafe wiring kit fitted to their vehicle. It must be connected to a constant 12V power source ie one that does not turn off with the ignition. Please confirm that you have the required wiring intact and that the LED in the yellow power lead is lit.

If you do not have a kit already in installed in your vehicle please contact us immediately
